Summit County Community Development Demolition Permit Submittal Completeness Checklist

In general, demo permits are required for the removal of structures. A separate demo permit is not required if the demo begins after submitting for a new building permit on the site. Below are examples of when a demo permit is required:

- Utilities are being disconnected or abandoned
- A structure is being removed and site restored to an empty lot
- A structure is being removed and not immediately rebuilt
- A structure is being demolished after experiencing fire damage
