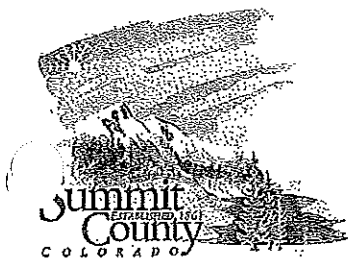

Dear Mr. Carlberg,

We appreciate your information on the anticipated service impacts in relation to the Farmers Korner North Plant Expansion project that the District is currently planning. We understand that this expansion will increase the total amount of solid waste in form of grits and screenings that are disposed of at our landfill from the current 330 gallons per day (about 1,950 kg per day) to an anticipated total amount of 720 gallons per day of (about 4,250 kg per day).

We do not anticipate any difficulties at this time in accepting solid waste generated at the expanded FKTP at our landfill operation.

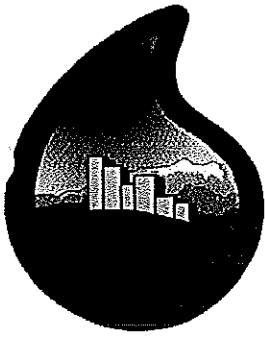
Service will be provided after engineering is completed, payment is received, any easements are signed and construction can be completed. We will have better information available after design has been completed as to a scheduled in-service date.

Dear Mr. Carlberg,

We appreciate your information on the anticipated service impacts in relation to the Farmers Korner North Plant Expansion project that the District is currently planning. We understand that this expansion will increase the amount of dewatered biosolids from currently about 40 dry tons per month at 19 percent solids to about 75 dry tons per month when the treatment capacity of the expanded FKTP campus is reached.

We do not anticipate any difficulties at this time in accepting biosolids generated at the expanded FKTP.

However, please note that this will mean that two loads will need to be removed per day during the busy winter season. This will result in some removal operations on Saturday and it will require some storage within the treatment plant due to impassable roads on various days during the winter. It will also require a second shift I am sure to assure that there is a load first thing in the morning to remove in addition to one in the mid-afternoon. I am sure with good communication between our operators these issues will be managed.
