Tax payments must be in the Summit County Office of the County Treasurer on or before October 19, 2009 in cash or certified funds to avoid delinquent property taxes going to tax lien sale to be held October 21, 2009. If the property goes through the tax lien sale, you will be required to pay investor's interest at the rate of ten percent (10%) per annum. Redemption of these taxes must be paid in cash or certified funds within three (3) years or a treasurer's deed may be issued to the investor. All payments must be made to Summit County Treasurer.
