SWAN MOUNTAIN ROAD CLOSURE FROM SUMMIT COVE (SNAKE RIVER INLET) TO SAPPHIRE POINT

Summit County, Colorado – The Summit County Road and Bridge Department will be closing Swan Mountain Road from Summit Cove (Snake River inlet) to Sapphire Point to all traffic for re-paving operations between the hours of 7:00 AM and 7:00 PM, Monday through Friday, beginning Wednesday, August 18 and continuing through Friday, August 27, 2010.

The road will be open each night between 7:00 PM and 7:00 AM Monday through Friday and open 24/7 on weekends. Additionally, access for emergency vehicles and access to the US Forest Service campgrounds on Swan Mountain Road will be made available during the paving project as needed.

No bicycle traffic will be allowed on the road; however, bicyclists are reminded to use the new bike path portion from Summit Cove to Sapphire Point, and Swan Mountain Road from Sapphire Point to Farmers Korner.

The public is urged to use caution while traveling through the project, and can expect grooved pavement conditions, uneven lanes, and no centerline striping.
